Wander around the magnificent gardens and parkland which includes an orangery, pond and fountains, then spend the afternoon by the superb swimming pool which can be heated on request. The château's excellent inhouse chef can prepare wonderful meals whether it's breakfast, a picnic basket for a day at the beach or an a la carte evening feast, or you may prefer to pre-arrange half-board and full-board options for your stay. The team is passionate about ensuring that guests have a memorable stay and can even organise local activities.

With such elegant château interiors and spacious grounds, this is the perfect place to enjoy a memorable holiday with family and friends, appreciating the tranquil and wonderful nature of this estate. The vibrant city of Béziers is under half an hour away or head to Mèze for oysters and white wine overlooking the







Étang de Thau. It's also just 20 minutes to reach the sandy shores of the Mediterranean at Vias Plage or there is a great range of beachside activities close to Agde and Marseillan Plage.

Closer to home, wine-lovers will adore the many charming wine villages and vineyards of this captivating part of the Languedoc countryside.

Location & Local Information

Château Du Capitaine is situated in the valley of the Hérault in Languedoc-Roussillon, ideally placed close to the historic town of Pézenas and within half an hour of Béziers and the beaches of the Mediterranean Sea.

Pézenas, the town of Molière, offers you a great choice of boutiques, restaurants, cafes, craft shops, as well as, on every Saturday morning, its grand market which is known to be one of the best in the region. In high season, twice weekly, all the small shops stay open until midnight and look out for Friday evening night markets with food, wine and music in July and August.

Close by, there is a wealth of little wine villages as well as beautiful local vineyards - after all, this is the Languedoc wine region and in the autumn you can sometimes hear the distant sound of farmers harvesting their grapes from the château. Keen walkers can follow trails through the garrigue, admiring the glorious landscapes of the Languedoc countryside, whilst there are cycling and horse-riding opportunities too.

Head to the Étang de Thau for a boat trip out to the Bouzigues oyster beds or simply enjoy them with a chilled glass of white wine in an atmospheric café in Mèze, a picturesque town which is worthy of a visit with its narrow lanes and fishing ports – travel on a Sunday morning to experience the vibrant market!

The long stretches of sandy coastline around Plage de Vias are around a 20-minute drive away or head a little further to Agde with its blue-flagged beaches and wealth of summer activities such as watersports, ball games and amusement parks. The pine forests and coastline around La Tamarissière are especially beautiful and wonderful for nature lovers.

Other attractions across the area include the Canal du Midi, fantastic for boat lovers and cyclists, the Lac du Salagou with its lakeside watersports and hiking trails as well as the exciting city of Béziers. Sète is another brilliant place to explore with its canals and seaside setting.

Further afield, spend the day in Carcassonne, just over 100km away, or visit other UNESCO World Heritage sites such as Saint-Guilhem-le-Désert, Nîmes' Roman remains and the incredible Pont du Gard.

- Security deposit: €3000 paid via bank transfer to the owner one month before arrival and refunded two weeks after departure, subject to full inspection.

- Linen & towels included?: Yes including mid-stay change for stays of 2 weeks.
- Pets welcome?: Not allowed.
- Other Ts and Cs: Weddings and special events/celebrations are on request only and subject to prior permission/arrangement with the owner and additional charges. Stag/hen parties are not allowed. Barbecues are only permitted on request, for château guests only and under supervision of the chef. The property sleeps 18 guests in the main château (8 bedrooms) and 4 guests in two eco tent lodges, set within the grounds. This is a catered venue so no kitchen facilities are available to guests. Guests can either arrange meals with the chef or book a half or full-board option. Please enquire for all catering prices. A minimum of half or full-board is obligatory for July and August see below. Only château guests can use the facilities and rooms of the château and grounds. You may be permitted limited guests for a brief visit but only with the owner's prior permission in order to maintain the protected and quiet nature of the château and its grounds. Half-board (or pre-arranged la carte meals with the chef) is obligatory for July and August, payable in advance to Oliver's Travels. Please see the 'Extras' tab for pricing. Air-conditioning is featured in all château bedrooms and eco lodge tents.
- Changeover day: Saturday. All other changeover days on request.
- End of stay cleaning available?: Yes (and mid-stay clean for stays of more than a week). However, guests are required to leave the accommodation clean, tidy and in the same condition as on their arrival. Any extra cleaning, laundry, maintenance and/or rubbish disposal required will be charged against the security deposit.
- Smoking Allowed?: Outside only in designated areas.
- Insurance: Guests are required to be in possession of a valid insurance policy, which covers them for cancellations, personal belongings, public liability and any accidental damage caused during their stay.
- Minimum stay: 4 nights. Stays of 2 and 3 nights are also available on request.
