Surrounded by a mélange of quiet, glistening black-sand beaches with the energising bustle of Canggu's teeming neighbourhoods, it is a cocoon of luxury and tranquility. Go on guided treks, forage through charming villages, or relax inside the villa with a refreshing Balinese massage — you'll find plenty of delight.

Tucked behind walls of dramatic rice terraces, Villa Malati welcomes you with spectacular outdoors. Recreating the charm of a beguiling rainforest, it boasts a serene, leafy garden with large sun umbrellas, rustling coconut palms, and comfy sea loungers that border a free-form emerald pool. Sweet-scented flora, and a bounty of lush, green trees engulf a traditional balé. Tastefully-manicured courtyards are complete with cascading fountains and fish ponds that overlook the sparkling river of Pangi.

The interiors are equally divine. Blending the splendour and glamour of a luxury retreat, with the earthy humility of its rustic surroundings, Villa Malati is a gift that keeps on giving.

The living room opens onto the sprawling outdoors. Wood-shingled ceilings compliment neat, white-washed upholstery. Warm colour tones and Asian antiques coalesce beautifully for an unforgettable atmosphere.

All three bedrooms stay true to the distinctly Balinese feel of the house. Each set in a pavilion of its own is flanked by a variety of fragrant greenery. Puffy canopy beds,



thatched rooftops and wooden flooring envelop a wealth of modern comfort, while the adjoining open decks are perfect for early-morning yoga sessions.

Make the most of the villa's charming garden bathrooms, fitted with teak walls, glossy bathtubs, and relaxing outdoor showers.

There's also an exclusive dining area, where you can sample local delicacies, and watch the sun go down. A traditional teak table seats six, adjacent to the roomy kitchen.

Unfinished terracotta brick walls, rustic doors and soothing decor reflect the rich heritage of the island. Not sparing on luxury, the villa provides a gamut of modern facilities — from cosy workspaces and a study, to speedy Wi-Fi with a team of warm, well-trained staff.

With its wealth of world-class galleries, stylish beach clubs, and majestic age-old temples, it's no wonder that Bali has become a melting pot of art and culture.

The sandy beach of Pererenan (2.3 km) is close by, and perfect for breezy afternoons. Canggu is a short distance away, where you can spend hours exploring boutiques, beaches and bazaars.

Forage through colourful neighbourhoods of Berawa (7.5 km), or bike around the rolling rice paddies of Jatiluwih (44 km).

Surfers won't get enough of the playful waves of Echo Beach (5.5 km), while Batu Bolong (5.7 km) offers a myriad of seafront spots, shops and restaurants.

The nightlife in Bali is second to none. Loop Pool Bar is close by, where you can drink, swim, and lounge for hours. For an unforgettable Indonesian fare, nothing beats Tugu Bali Restaurant (5.6 km). Treat yourself to authentic flavours made from recipes passed down from generations, all using spices and ingredients from different parts of the country.
