Overview

Landscope House is a phenomenal Grade II listed manor house in Devon's beautiful South Hams, offering luxurious accommodation for up to sixteen guests across eight elegant bedroom suites. Surrounded by several hundred acres of countryside, the estate also includes The Barns, restored dairy buildings providing additional boutique accommodation for up to twelve more guests if required. With lavish interiors, expansive grounds and excellent event facilities, the estate is ideal for celebrations, family gatherings, weddings and corporate stays.

Originally built around 1840, the manor house has been beautifully restored to combine period character with contemporary comfort. Grand living spaces include a drawing room, reading room, dining room and an impressive open-plan kitchen, conservatory and family room designed for sociable stays. The bedrooms are individually styled with luxurious beds, vintage touches and marble-clad bathrooms, while several feature freestanding baths, exposed beams or countryside views.

Outside, the grounds are just as impressive, with landscaped gardens, alfresco dining areas, a lily pond, lake and an outdoor swimming pool overlooking the estate. Guests can also make use of the Glasshouse event space, the converted Dairy Kitchen and the extensive meadow, ideal for marquees and outdoor celebrations. Just three miles from Dartmoor and close to Devon's coastline, Landscope House is perfectly placed for exploring charming villages, beaches, walking trails and nearby attractions including Buckfast Abbey, Dartmouth and Totnes.

Location & Local Information

Landscape House enjoys a wonderful setting in Devon's South Hams, surrounded by hundreds of acres of countryside and just three miles from Dartmoor National Park. The nearby village of Landscape is home to the charming Hill House Nursery and Gardens, while Buckfastleigh offers cafés, shops and the much-loved South Devon Railway, where heritage steam trains travel through the scenic River Dart valley to Totnes. The area is ideal for walking, cycling and exploring Devon's countryside and coastline.

Within easy reach are some of South Devon's most popular towns and attractions, including Dartmouth, Salcombe and Kingsbridge. Dartmouth's historic streets, marina and riverside setting are filled with galleries, restaurants and waterside activities, while Salcombe is renowned for its beaches, sailing and coastal scenery. Visitors can also explore Greenway House, once Agatha Christie's holiday home, enjoy walks around Dittisham and the Dart Valley, or spend days by the sea at Slapton Sands, Bantham and Bigbury-on-Sea.
