

Villa Subat

Overview

For a holiday in a tranquil setting, Villa Subat in Islamlar, Turkey offers a two-bedroom property located in the foothills of the Taurus Mountains. The villa features views across the valley towards the sea, complemented by modern interiors, a large outdoor swimming pool, and a Jacuzzi bathtub.

Villa Subat includes amenities such as a sauna, hammam, and gym. The property is arranged over two floors and comprises a double bedroom – with a furnished balcony and a circular Jacuzzi – and a twin bedroom, also with a furnished balcony and views of the surrounding mountains. The interiors are modern, with a neutral palette of whites and creams, accented by colourful soft furnishings.

The open-plan living, kitchen, and dining area provides direct access to the pool terrace, where a large swimming pool is a central feature. The terrace also offers a day bed, sun loungers, cushioned seating, and a coffee table. A shaded area with a dining table and barbecue facilitates outdoor meals.

With its quiet location, Villa Subat provides a setting suited to those seeking a private retreat for spending time with friends and family while enjoying the natural landscape. The villa is fully air-conditioned and equipped with Chesterfield-style sofas, an LED television, and a DVD player. The fitness room includes a cross trainer, treadmill, free weights, and large windows overlooking the scenery. After exercising, guests can make use of the sauna or steam room.

Islamlar remains largely unaffected by mass tourism, offering a calm environment with local attractions. The nearby town of Kalkan, situated around a historic harbour



and sheltered by the Taurus Mountains, presents opportunities for swimming, water sports, and outdoor activities.

Location & Local Information

Set in the foothills of the majestic Taurus Mountains on Turkey's Mediterranean coast, the village of İslamlar offers an authentic glimpse into rural Turkish life. This serene and unspoilt location strikes the perfect balance between peaceful seclusion and easy access to the vibrant town of Kalkan. The villa is situated in a countryside setting, yet conveniently close to local restaurants and small shops - all within walking distance for daily essentials.

In and around İslamlar, visitors can experience the charm of traditional Turkish culture. Wander through olive groves and vineyards, or enjoy a meal at one of the renowned trout farm restaurants, celebrated for their locally sourced ingredients and sweeping valley views. The villa also offers proximity to sections of the Lycian Way Trail - an exceptional coastal hiking route ideal for active travellers.


A fifteen-minute drive brings you to Kalkan, once a simple fishing village and now a picturesque harbour town located between Kas and Fethiye. Kalkan is famed for its whitewashed houses cascading towards the turquoise sea, framed by vibrant bougainvillaea. The town's atmospheric rooftop restaurants and harbour-side cafes provide the perfect backdrop for leisurely lunches or memorable evening dinners.

The coastline offers a selection of pristine beaches, including the well-known Kaputas Beach and the expansive sands of Patara Beach, both equipped with cafes, loungers, and sunshades. For a different perspective, board a traditional wooden gulet from Kalkan harbour and cruise along the coast's dramatic scenery. For those seeking a cultural experience, a trip to Kekova to explore its submerged ancient ruins is easily arranged, with boats departing from Kas, approximately a 30-minute drive from Kalkan.

- Islamlar village is quiet and peaceful, in fact usually, only the call of the mosque and the cry of cockerels disturbs you.
- The villa is in a small cluster with Villas Mart (<https://www.oliverstravels.com/turkey/islamlar/villa-mart/>), Nisan (<https://www.oliverstravels.com/turkey/islamlar/villa-nisan/>) & Mayis (<https://www.oliverstravels.com/turkey/islamlar/villa-mayis/>), so they can be booked together. They have been sympathetically built so none are visible from each other once inside or by the pool.

Terms & Conditions

- **Security deposit:** No security deposit is taken however clients will be liable for any damage or losses during their stay.
- **Arrival time:** 16.00
- **Departure time:** 10.00 am
- **Energy costs included?**: Included in the rental price
- **Linen & towels included?**: Linen & towels included in the rental price
- **Pets welcome?**: Pets not allowed
- **Other Ts and Cs:** Please note that on occasions, in Turkey, extremes in weather can cause water and/ or electric supply to be cut or reduced. Services are normally restored as soon as possible

Travelling to Turkey

All British (and most other nationalities) citizens require a full 10 year passport with at least 6 months validity to enter Turkey. UK passport holders are exempt from visa for tourist visits of up to 90 days within 180 days starting from the first entry date. For all other passports please visit the Turkish Government Website (<https://www.evisa.gov.tr/en/>) or the *Turkish Consulate* for details of whether you require a visa or not.

Whilst in Turkey local regulations require you keep your passport and a printed copy of your e-visa with you at all times.
