Overview

Imagine enjoying a home-cooked meal while sitting right at the water's edge overlooking Lake Garda. An after-dinner dip would take you less than a minute as you dive into the glistening water looking back on your home away from home.

This villa is an ideal place to stay when you visit the region, not only for its lakefront location but it also oozes Italian charm, with a traditional garden filled with lemon trees and a charming balcony lined with fresh blooms.

As you enter the home, you're welcomed into a homely and charming space with pops of bright colour. The living-dining room is open-plan and decorated with original art pieces. The lake vista can be enjoyed both from the comfort of the sofas and the dining table, both of which are large enough to seat the whole group. Meals can be prepared in the cosy kitchen, which has everything you need to cook up a feast as well as a few luxuries including a Nespresso machine. In the evening, have movie nights on the flat screen television or enjoy some downtime on the Playstation 2.

With six bedrooms and three bathrooms, this villa accommodates 12 guests comfortably. The bedrooms consist of four doubles, a room with bunk beds and one with twins – so whether you're a family, a couple or a group of friends there's rooms to suit everybody. If you want a little extra added calmness, enjoy the dedicated relaxation room that offers a sauna/hammam and is finished with mosaic tiles.

Location & Local Information

Lette Placa is located in a slice of paradise on the western shore of Lake Garda. This part of the lake is famed for its extraordinary climate and the south sun exposure, so you will want to spend as much time around the lake and in the water as possible on the wide, beautiful beaches.

Within a short drive (2.5km) you can be in the local village. There are also incredible views across the lakes onto the mountains, and it makes the perfect backdrop for a holiday. You can wander the antique alleys that have a fairy tale feel to them, exploring restaurants, bars and shops that line the streets. Despite being a relatively small village, there are two Michelin starred restaurants here!

There's plenty to do here, from exploring the impressive palace to taking in the places of historical interest, such as the church and bell tower. This area also offers a lot of sporting activities, from sailing and windsurfing to mountain biking and horse riding, as well as having a port for boat trips to other parts of Lake Garda.

Limone Sul Garda is just a short 25-minute drive away (20km), here you can explore the historic old town. Toscolano Maderno is also near, just a 15-minute drive away (10km). And here you can enjoy beaches, restaurants and bars, as well as a few shops for the essentials.

Just a little further along is Gardone Riviera, a 22-minute drive (15km). This tourist hot-spot has plenty to do from exploring the whimsical botanic garden of André Heller, swinging from the trees at Rimbalzello Adventure park or wandering back in time at Vittoriale Degli Italiani, the former writer's home.

The villa is ideally located near other towns and villages around Lake Garda that are well worth a day-trip, including Malcesine (48km) and Sirmione (59km).
