Overview

Thousands of plants inhabit the gardens of this villa in Umbria, where there's always something in bloom. Here valleys and green hills embrace you from the moment you enter the winding drive, which passes through the estate's working farm. If you're looking for bucolic retreat, this stately stone home and gardens will catch your imagination and your heart. Whether you dine beneath the picture-perfect pergola, or lounge beside the private pool, a profound sense of calm will find you at this holiday villa.

Inside, the decor is sophisticated yet casual - with tasteful wicker and floral fabrics winking at the gardens beyond. There is an updated en suite bathroom for every bedroom, so all your guests will be kept in comfort. For even more luxury and care, upgrade your stay to include breakfast every morning, daily maid service, and more.

Golfers will be especially enamoured of this holiday villa - there is an 18 hole golf course just 3 minutes down a private path. The nearest town is San Giovanni del Pantano (1 km), which sits just 25 minutes from the Perugia International Airport - excellent convenience for a rural escape to another world!

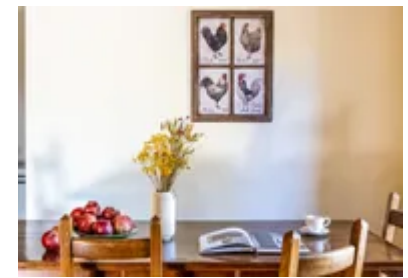

Location & Local Information

With over 30 per cent of the region's total area made up of woodland, Umbria is known as "the Green Heart of Italy". Villa Caminata has the unique advantage of being situated in the very centre of this area steeped with history and tradition.

Umbria is one of Italy's most beautiful and enchanting regions. This tranquil land of saints and ancient mystics, with its romantic countryside and its historically rich medieval hill-towns, inspires a special reverence in the hearts of Italians as well as the foreigners visiting it. More than anywhere else, the region seems to represent the country's spirituality.

With less than a million inhabitants, Umbria's population density is half that of the national average, affording ample room for individuality. The simple pleasures of country living, surrounded by natural beauty, is enhanced with art, architecture, wonderful food and wine in nearby towns and cities throughout the two adjoining regions of Lazio and Tuscany.

Florence and Rome are within two hours drive. Siena, Arezzo, Assisi, Todi and Orvieto are all closely linked. The capital city of Perugia is just 20 minutes away and offers a wealth of cultural activities that include opera and the famous Umbria Jazz festival, held every July. Other spectacular hilltop towns include Cortona and Poggio. Poggio has an annual classical music festival and the annual Montone Film Festival, which attracts an international audience.

During the summer months, open-air concerts and operas are often staged in the gardens of famous villas and palazzos that abound throughout the region.

Many tours and excursions can be organized for our guests during their stay by the Estate's Management.

Guests have access to an 18 hole championship golf course, designed by Robert Trent Jones Jr. A golf clubhouse and restaurant facilities within the same estate are only 3 minutes distance from the villa. These are accessible by golf cart through a private pathway that runs across the nature reserve. All guests have discounts on the golf green fees and at the clubhouse restaurant.

Furthermore, there are a wide range of outdoor pursuits and activities including hunting, fishing and mountain biking.

History

This country estate has risen majestically in the midst of the Umbrian region for more than a millennium.

Inhabited since prehistoric times, the estate has been witness to many historical events, which helped shape the Italy we know today. Murlo is situated at the very top of a beautiful hill in the midst of Monte Elceto di Murlo and Monte Tezio. It is an easily defensible and dominant position.

Terms & Conditions

- **Security deposit:** €1500 charged to client's credit card by the owner as a pre-authorisation upon arrival and refunded two weeks after departure, subject to full inspection.
- **Arrival time:** 4.00 p.m. - 8.00 p.m. Check-in outside this time may be subject to an extra cost. Please enquire for more details.
- **Departure time:** 10.00 a.m.
- **Energy costs included?:** Yes.
- **Linen & towels included?:** Yes (towels are changed mid-week and linen is changed mid-stay for bookings of two consecutive weeks).
- **Other Ts and Cs:** Weddings, stag/hen parties and events are not allowed.
 Please note that extra services/activities must be booked via the Estate's concierge in advance - no external providers are welcome at the property.
 Please note home security devices may be installed at the villa, please enquire for further information.

- **Changeover day:** Saturday in high season. Flexible during all other periods.
- **End of stay cleaning available?:** Yes. However, guests are required to leave the accommodation clean, tidy and in the same condition as on their arrival. Any extra cleaning, laundry, maintenance and/or rubbish disposal required will be charged against the security deposit.
- **Minimum stay:** 7 nights in high season. 2 nights during all other periods.
- **Heating costs included?:** Yes, except in low season.
- **Pool heating charge?:** Included approximately late June to end-August, on request only. Extra cost approximately late-May to late June and September based on consumption, payable locally. Pool heating is not available during all other periods. Please note that like all heated pools, pool heating and water temperature are reliant on weather and outside temperatures.
- **Tax:** Italian Visitors Tax payable locally in cash (typically costs €1-€10 per adult per night- please enquire if exact amount is required).
- **Internet access?:** Wi-Fi internet access included.
- **Pool towels included?:** Yes, changed weekly for bookings of 2 weeks or more.
- **Pool opening dates?:** The pool is open approximately May to September. Please note that pool opening dates are subject to local weather conditions and pool maintenance requirements and that cooler months may not be suitable for swimming.
