Loch Ness and the Black Isle offer additional adventures, including boat cruises and charming seaside villages to explore. - For groups larger than 14 people, two high-end cottages also on the Reserve are available. Highland Retreat (<https://www.oliverstravels.com/britain-ireland/scotland/highlands/highland-retreat/>) sleeps up to 8, whilst Glen Rest (<https://www.oliverstravels.com/britain-ireland/scotland/highlands/glen-rest/>) can accommodate up to 4.

There is also an additional cleaning fee to cover the extra cleaning requirements of £200 per dog per stay. Please enquire at the time of booking.
