A poolside pergola provides a haven for outdoor living, featuring cozy seating where you can unwind and dine al fresco using the available barbecue.

For the ultimate relaxation, the hammock area beckons you to swing gently while stealing glimpses of the sparkling Aegean Sea through picturesque stone-framed windows. But the most coveted spot to witness the renowned Mykonos sunsets is the rooftop terrace. From this vantage point, the breathtaking views of the rolling hills adorned with white houses and the vibrant blue sea inlets are nothing short of awe-inspiring.

Simplicity reigns supreme at Villa Ixos, evident in the uniform bedroom decor that runs throughout the property. These meticulously designed bedrooms prioritize restful sleep, featuring soundproofing and exceptionally comfortable beds adorned with pristine linens. Location & Local Information

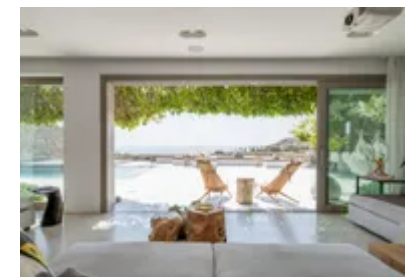
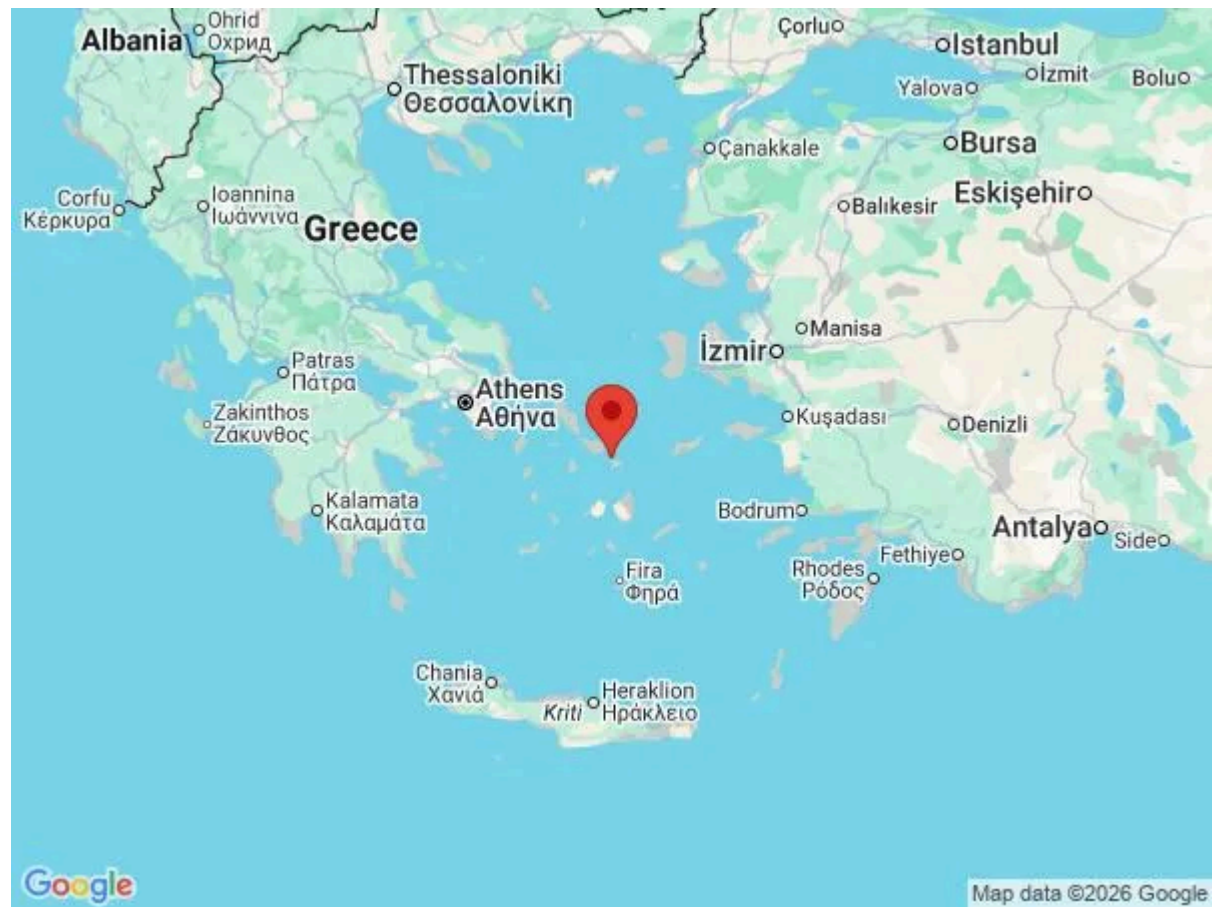
Nestled in the tranquil northern enclave of Mykonos known as Kastro, within Fanari, lies this remarkable villa. Conveniently situated just a short drive away from both Mykonos town and the New Port, and a mere 18 minutes from the airport, its location offers ease of access for visitors. The rooftop unveils a captivating panorama that includes the iconic octagonal-towered lighthouse situated in the area. This functioning lighthouse plays a crucial role in guiding maritime traffic between the island and its neighboring counterpart, Tinos. The spectacle of sunset from this vantage point is truly breathtaking.

Mykonos, a distinguished gem of the Cycladic region in the deep blue expanse of the Aegean Sea, is renowned worldwide. This idyllic island boasts a myriad of treasures, from upscale dining and exceptional shopping to its world-famous beaches. As the sun sets, the island comes alive with an electric nightlife. Nearby, Fanari Castle stands as the last vestige of the Byzantine-era fortifications. Positioned on a hillside, this fortress, dating back to the 12th century, remains remarkably well-preserved, a testament to its historical significance.

Mykonos Town, an artistic and fashionable hub, offers enchanting explorations through its labyrinthine alleys. The dazzling white Cycladic architecture adorned with bougainvillea is nothing short of picturesque. Matogianni Street serves as an excellent starting point, lined with charming boutiques and souvenir shops, exuding a bustling and romantic ambiance. Art enthusiasts can indulge their curiosity at various intriguing galleries in town, such as the Dio Horia. Mykonos Town has its iconic array of seven windmills, a sight immediately recognizable from postcards. These windmills, thought to have been constructed by the Venetians, have become symbolic of the island and historically powered local mills. Alefkandra Harbour, affectionately dubbed "Little Venice," adds to the island's charm with its cobblestone walkways and coastal dining spots. It's an Instagrammers dream! Sit here for a cocktail whilst the waves lap up.

Of course, Mykonos is equally renowned for its pristine beaches that adorn every corner of the island. The untamed and secluded beaches grace the northern expanse, while the more popular ones embrace the southern shores. In the southern part of the island, Elia Beach stands out as an exceptional choice, boasting the title of Mykonos' longest beach. With its well-organized facilities and vibrant atmosphere, it's an excellent spot for relaxation. The golden sands and pebbles, nestled amid verdant slopes, offer not only beachside enjoyment but also the opportunity to climb up for a spectacular hillside view.

Agios Stefanos Beach, conveniently located near both the villa and Mykonos Town, is a hot spot during the summer months. Its turquoise waters glisten invitingly, providing a perfect backdrop for water sports enthusiasts. Meanwhile, Paradise Beach is the epicenter of lively parties and vibrant festivities.

- Pool maintained twice a week, and heated to a maximum of 28°C.

Terms & Conditions

- **Security deposit:** €3000 by credit card on arrival
- **Arrival time:** 4 pm
- **Departure time:** 10 am
- **Linen & towels included?:** Linen, bath and pool towels included in the rental price. Linen and towels are changed twice a week.
- **Pets welcome?:** Not allowed
- **Other Ts and Cs:** There is in-house housekeeping. Working hours 8:00 - 12:00 & 13.00 - 16.00. Laundry facilities are managed by the housekeeper upon request with extra charge €10/hour.
- **End of stay cleaning:** Standard changeover clean included in the price. Guests are required to leave the accommodation clean, tidy and in the same condition as on their arrival. Any extra cleaning, laundry, maintenance and/or rubbish disposal required will be charged against the security deposit.
- **Other Cleaning:** Pool is cleaned twice a week.
- **Smoking Allowed?:** Not permitted inside the villa
- **Other 2:** Pool maintenance twice a week.
- **Other 3:** Please note that on occasions, in Greece, extremes in weather can cause water and/ or electric supply to be cut or reduced. Services are normally restored as soon as possible.
- **Minimum stay:** May & September : 5 days June, July & August : 7 days

- **Internet access?:** The property has complimentary Wifi connection. It is good to note that the speed is dependent on local provider and technical issues may cause reduced speed or cut of service.
